As a Child he grew up in abusive home. One day a preacher came knocking on his door. He asked Lee Lads father "Can I come in and talk to you about Jesus?" His father's response was "you can come but it won't do any good", but "we don't turn away company." That night the family surrendered their lives to the Lord. The family got baptized and he watch his father transform. Six months later his father went off to college to become a preacher. Now Lee Lad preaches at 4 different Correctional Facilities a week. Currently Lee Lad and his staff minister at seven different Correctional Facilities. He baptizes hundreds every year at the Marion County Jail.
